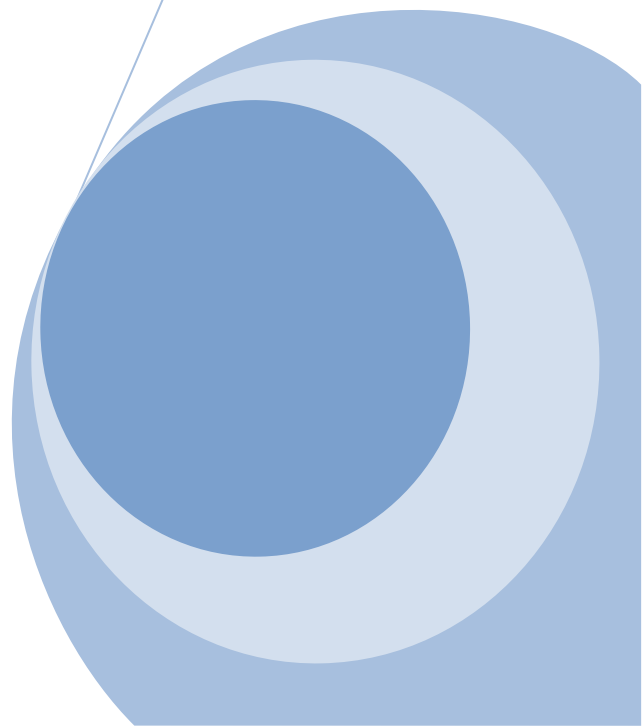
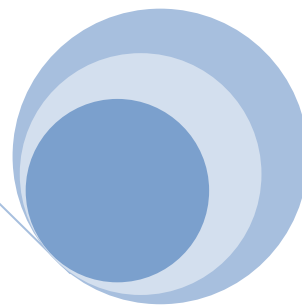
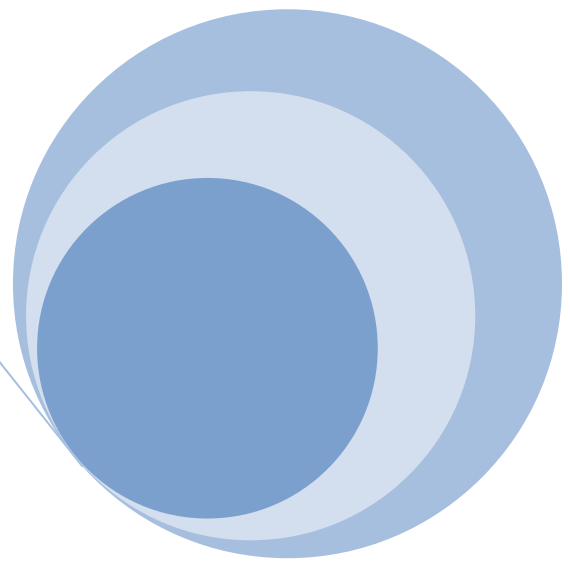

◆ Submission

Please submit your manuscripts online by http://bai-conference.org/isfa_2011.html

Submission Deadline: March 31, 2011

Scholars are invited to submit their abstract(s) or full paper(s) electronically via email. All abstracts or full papers must be submitted electronically in DOC or PDF format.

Acceptance notification will be sending out within three weeks after your submission. If you need to get the acceptance letter to apply visa or to get your financial sponsor from your university, please let us know and submit your manuscript as early as possible.

◆ **Manuscript Format**

The ISFA2011 follows the journal format of Emerging Markets Finance and Trade (http://www.mesharpe.com/journal_info/ree.htm). In general, the paper must be prepared the way you want it to appear in the proceedings. Authors could choose to publish their full papers or one-page abstracts in the conference proceedings in CD-ROM. All papers must be original and not published anywhere. However, the authors do not need to transfer copyright of papers or abstracts included in the proceedings. This means authors could submit their articles for journals or books after the conference.

Your submitted manuscript will be including in conference proceedings (CD-ROM). Please upload your final version manuscript via <http://182.50.142.182/BAI/>. If you need to change file, the deadline for final submission (full papers or abstracts, authors could choose to publish their full papers or one- page abstracts in the conference proceedings) is May 15, 2011. If authors do not submit their final version manuscripts, the original submission manuscripts will be used for the conference proceedings. That is, May 15, 2011 is the last date to update or revise the manuscripts. After that, conference proceedings (CD-ROM) will be finalized.

◆ **Registration**

Registration will begin on May 1, 2011. The registration fee is US\$380 per person/paper. The registration deadline is May 15, 2011.

◆ Publication Opportunities

ISFA2011 is a part of BAI2011. All accepted papers will be included in BAI2011 conference proceedings (CD-ROM) with ISSN number. Besides, some outstanding papers may be published in one of the following two journals.

Emerging Markets Finance and Trade (SSCI)

Selected papers would be considered for publication in a special issue of the Emerging Markets Finance and Trade (EMFT), an SSCI journal edited by Professor Ali M. Kutan, PhD., Southern Illinois University Edwardsville, USA. He will also be the honor guest of ISFA2011 conference.

Immediately following the conference, the Editor will email the authors of the selected papers and inform them about the submission procedure to the SSCI Journal of the Emerging Markets Finance and Trade. There is a US\$ 100 submission fee for all submissions, which provides a free online access to the EMFT and a free membership in the Society for the Study of the Emerging Markets, which publishes the EMFT, and no submission fee for additional submissions during the year of the membership. Manuscripts will be subject to a blind review procedure

After the review procedure, the authors of the accepted papers need to pay a publishing fee of US\$ 1,000 per paper up to 20 article pages (double-space, Times new roman, 12 font size); plus \$100 per additional page.. This fee is for covering the publication cost of the special issue and to get the papers published quickly without significant publication lags. The fee goes the Journal's publisher, not to ISFA2011. Authors do not need to pay the publishing fee it until their manuscripts are accepted.

Contemporary Management Research

All full papers accepted in conference may be considered to be published in the Contemporary Management Research (CMR, <http://cmr-journal.org>), a refereed, international journal with ISSN number. The authors may decide to submit or not their manuscripts to CMR. Authors who hope to submit manuscripts to CMR must follow the procedure of CMR manuscript submission. The CMR imposes page fees on all accepted manuscripts. These fees are necessary to offset the very substantial cost of putting a manuscript into print. The CMR page fee is \$35.00 per page in 2011.
